evenue Minister K. Rajan says that village officers have to play a leadership role in making village offices in the state people-friendly and corruption-free. His words are literally being implemented today. The employees of the Revenue Department are also congratulated for their sincere work towards the realisation of the objective of the Revenue Department of Land and Document for everyone and making all services smart. The determination and willpower of the government has been reflected in the distribution of land in Wayanad district. It is a record that 1739 pattayas were

distributed in Wayanad only after this government came to power. All these title files have been pending for years in various legal entanglements and other issues. As part of the government's goal of "Land for all, records for all services, and making every service smart", this great achievement was possible due to Rajan's discussions and interventions.

Decades-old and pending issues like acquisition and grant of title to surplus land of Harrison Estate, grant of title to holders of Narikal surplus land in Tirunelly village, grant of title to holders of Cheengeri Tribal Extension Scheme in Sultan Batheri Ambalavyal village etc. 1739 families have become land heirs as a result of the systematic work done by this government since coming to power to settle these. Lack of surveyors to survey the land and prepare records was the main obstacle. The survey director was instructed to allocate necessary surveyors and survey equipment to this and complete the survey process in time.

The role played by the district administration in taking necessary steps for the urgent disposal of the cases pending in the court proceedings is also not negligible as the district collector and the revenue officials up to the village officers should be mentioned.



Extensive digital re-survey process started on November 1, 2022. As a part of implementing the government policy, Kerala has been digitally surveyed in the most scientific manner for four

years and a part of the Digital Reserve has been inaugurated by the Hon'ble Chief Minister of Kerala in a program to be held at the Tagore Theatre in Thiruvananthapuram on November 1st. For the first time in the history of the formation of Kerala, the government has been spearheading the process of fully measuring Kerala. The government intends to complete the reserve in 4 years. Reserve proceedings in our state were started in 1966, but due to lack of modern technology and inadequacy of traditional systems, the reserve proceedings could not be completed even after 56 years. It is in this context that the Kerala government has decided

to start a digital survey in the state called 'Ente Bhoomi' using the most modern technologies and complete it in a timely manner.

The total cost of the digital survey project implemented across the state is expected to be ₹858.42 crore. Out of this, ₹ 438.46 crore has been allocated to the Department of Survey and Land Records from the Rebuild Kerala Initiative for the first phase of the project. The technical staff of the Survey and Land Records Department is insufficient to prepare digital survey records of all the villages in the state within four years. As a solution to this. 4700 people including 1500 surveyors and 3200 helpers will be hired on contract basis through employment exchange to complete the survey in time. The process of interviewing the candidates who have completed the written test and qualified for the appointment of surveyors on contract basis is in progress. Currently, the aim is to complete the digital reserve of the state with emphasis on unsurveyed villages and villages that have not been completed till date. 400 villages each in the first three years of the project and 350 villages in the fourth year and a total of 1550 villages will be completed within four years.

Sophisticated survey equipment such as Real Time Kinematic (RTK) Rover,

Robotic Total Station and Tablet PC are provided and the equipment is operated within the limits of the GPS Network called Continuously Operating Reference Station (CORS) and it is intended to carry out digital survey in a unified way and to execute the measures completely software-based. Up to 70 per cent of the state will be assisted by RTK rover machines, 20 per cent where satellite signals are relatively unavailable, robotic total station machines and 10 percent of the most open areas will use drone technology for digital survey. According to the topography of the state, 28 COR stations are required across the state. Its construction work has been completed and the COR stations have been commissioned. Construction work of CORS Control Center is in progress at the Survey Directorate. The equipment to be installed in the control centre has been delivered. The work of setting it up will be completed soon.

The aim is to prepare records in a fully IT-based manner using advanced survey techniques based on past experience in reserve survey procedures.

In order to make all the steps of the digital survey project from the beginning to the end transparent, the Department of Survey and Land Records has set up an online portal called 'Ente Bhoomi' to bring out all the information related to the project to the general public.

E-cards will be distributed in the state from now on. If the titles printed on the currently issued paper were lost, it was difficult to make copies. In revenue offices, title files are kept only for a specific period.

The main feature of this digital survey project is that the land related services of the Survey. Revenue, and Registration Departments can be delivered to the people in a timely manner through a single window online system. The important benefits of this digital survey project are that it will be possible to maintain the survey records without obsolete information so that there is no need for any more resurvey, and it will revolutionise the development efforts of the state to transform all land records into an IT-based service.

As part of the digital survey project, it is aimed to prepare a comprehensive GIS database for the benefit of all the departments of the state by including the information required for revenue administration and topographical information of Kerala as part of the project. It is the right of a citizen to have an exact and undisputed right to own land. In order to provide land ownership and accurate measurement through digital survey, participation and cooperation of land owners is essential. The aim is to sensitise people about the digital survey measures and complete the survey activities in a timely manner with public participation.

The digital survey project is being implemented in the state with mass participation. In order to complete the project as planned, public participation is required to take steps prior to the survey such as clearly marking the boundaries of their land and establishing the boundaries before the survey date if there are no clear boundaries. Many land complaints have been caused due to surveys being conducted without the presence of landowners and taking action by publicising the survey records long after the survey was conducted. Therefore, in digital survey, the survey is conducted in the presence of the landowners and the maps are prepared in the field. Digital survey is completely software-based. In order to sensitise the general public and ensure public participation in the Digital Survey process, Survey Sabhas were organised in a manner similar to Grama Sabhas in collaboration with the Local Self-

Government Department in 200 villages across the state selected for the first phase of the survey. The importance of digital survey, the role of people in the project, and the benefits of the digital survey project have been explained and a clear guideline has been provided in the survey councils. The huge public participation received by the survey councils is proof that people have embraced the digital survey project.

E-cards will be distributed in the state from now on. If the titles printed on the currently issued paper were lost, it was difficult to make copies. In revenue offices, title files are kept only for a specific period. Therefore, the title deed should have been found and a copy given. E-cards are a solution to this problem. Information of softwarebased issued e-cards will be stored in the State Data Centre. These are labels with QR code and digital signature. In the first phase, the cry certificates issued by the Land Tribunal were converted into ecards. Subsequently, 'Bhoomi pathivu patayams' will also be converted into e-pattayams. As these are linked to the revenue department's release software, inflows and outflows can be made without a separate application. Land fraud through fake land titles can also be prevented as authenticity of land titles can be verified through QR code. As an e-card is linked with Aadhaar, information about cards issued to an individual is available.

In applications for conversion of paddy fields and wetlands, priority will be given to those allotted houses under the LIFE scheme. Instructions for this have been given to the RDOs. Priority will be given to those who apply for treatment and loan assistance to those suffering from serious illness. A special operating procedure has been devised for expeditious processing of declassification applications. Of the 2, 26,901 applications received by this government, 94.71 percent of them have been processed. The minister also said that a weekly meeting of junior and senior superintendents is held under the leadership of the RDO to ensure that specific procedures are followed.







erala won the award for the state that provided the least costly treatments in the central government's Arogya Manthan 4.0. The state's Karunya Arogya Suraksha Scheme (KASP) bagged the best performing state award for highest scheme utilisation. The work of Minister Veena George, who is leading the department from the front with a group of health workers ready for action, cannot be overlooked here. The Government Medical Colleges at Kozhikode and Kottayam are leading in the highest number of scheme utilisation in the country. The reason for choosing Kerala was that the scheme could benefit up to 180 patients per hour (maximum 3 patients per minute). Currently, the service of the scheme is available in 200 government hospitals and 544 private hospitals in Kerala.

Health Minister Veena George said that the state is trying to provide medical assistance tos maximum number of people through the Karunya Arogya Sukhara Scheme. This is in recognition of the excellent work done by the state for medical assistance. A State Health Agency (SHA) was formed under the State Health Department for the successful implementation of the CASP scheme. The minister said that SHA played a big role in coordinating treatments with the participation of private hospitals. The aim of the government is to promote research, including in the field of medical education. Research will be encouraged among medical students and teachers. As part of the State Health Department's campaign 'Alapam Shraddha Sanathan Sangham', more than 10 lakh people were screened at their homes for diagnosis of lifestyle diseases. This target was achieved within two months of starting the project. Controlling and preventing lifestyle diseases are essential in maintaining people's health and boosting immunity. The aim is to control the diseases by ensuring the necessary treatment for those with lifestyle diseases and to provide the necessary support to prevent the diseases for those who are at risk.

This is one of the most important activities conceived and implemented during the tenure of this government through Ardram Mission as a part of Navkerala Karma Yojana II. For this purpose, the Minister directed to examine the possibility of cancer control

and palliative care while developing the Shayla app and these were included. Screening for cancer is carried out by a specialist in the camps. Specialist inspection has been started by holding such camps in the Wayanad and Pathanamthitta districts.

As part of this campaign, health workers visit people above 30 years of age and carry out screening to find out the risk of disease. Free diagnosis and treatment are provided to those who need it. Within two months of the project, 10, 22, 680 people across the state were screened for lifestyle diseases through home visits. Out of that 20.45 percent (2, 09,149) fell under the risk factor group of any serious disease. They have been subjected to expert examination. This project will bring about a big change in the health sector of the state. By early detection and treatment of lifestyle diseases and cancer, the disease can be treated and cured without complications. Through this project, a large section of the population can be freed from such diseases.

A neonatology department was started for the first time in Kozhikode Medical College for the special intensive care of new-borns. Excellent facilities are provided to ensure adequate care for mother and baby. The Minister also stated that as a result of this, the target was approved. Endoscope, Colonoscopy, Endoscopy System in Gastroenterology Department, Navigation System for Knee Replacement Surgery in Orthopaedics Department, Video Bronchoscope with Video Processor in Pulmonology Medicine, Cardiopulmonary Test Equipment, Multipara Monitor in Anaesthesia Department, High end Anaesthesia Work station, Flexible Intubation Video Endoscope, 4K Ultra High Definition Camera Endoscopy System in the ENT have been approved and installed. Other major equipment in the category are IABP Machine in CVTS, Laser Machine in General Surgery, 4K 3D Endoscopy System and OT Light Double DOOM in Pediatric Surgery. ₹4.02 Crore has been sanctioned for

various categories of reagents, dialysis

kits, chemicals and hospital accessories like triple blood bags. ₹2.91 Crore has been sanctioned for the renovation of toilets in various wards of the hospital block. Institute of Chest Diseases and IMCH, renovation of kitchen and laundry, interlocking of Tertiary Cancer Center, construction of volleyball court, street light, ceiling fans and other renovations are also in place.

The first phase of making lab test results available on mobile phones in Thiruvananthapuram Medical College has started. The action is part of the quality improvement initiative being implemented in the medical college. As part of this project, the hospital's lab sample collection centre and test result centre have been consolidated. So patients in different blocks of the hospital will have their test results available in their respective blocks. Apart from this, the test results are also available on mobile phones. The minister also clarified that this service is available to patients who have completed phone number verification. The test results of the labs are available 24 hours a day from the unified result counter inside the hospital. As a part of e-health initiatives, a system has been introduced to buy OP tickets without queuing in the medical college. Moreover, the date and token for follow-up treatment can be taken in advance with this system while visiting the doctor.

The Quality Improvement Initiative to improve the service quality of medical colleges was first started in Thiruvananthapuram Medical College. The supervisory committee is a team comprising senior doctors from other medical colleges. The main objective was to ensure that those who arrive at the emergency department receive expert examination and treatment without delay. Many people have mentioned the difficulty that the patients' relatives have to go to the labs in different parts of the medical college. That is why this has also been included in the Quality Improvement Initiative, the minister said.



Night tourism will be started in the state and will be implemented in Thiruvananthapuram district in the first phase, and preparations are underway to provide facilities for enjoying art performances and dining at night two days a month. The event will be held on the second Saturdays and Sundays of every month.

The old iron bridge of Feroke, which is also a siginificant monument of the struggle against foreign tyranny, was renovated and opened to the public during this period. The one-and-ahalf-century-old, British-built bridge was rusting and in danger. The bridge, designed as a heritage monument with visual beauty, was opened for traffic by Minister Muhammad Riyas. With ₹90 lakhs in the first phase of renovation, the rust on the bridge was completely removed using machines. The bridge was strengthened by filling the holes and strengthening the beams. Nine steel arches that were about to collapse were replaced with new ones. A new height gauge has also been installed to control taller vehicles.

At Feroke and Cheruvannur, welcome towers were also built and arrangements were made to prevent the bridge from rusting. Both sides of the road leading to the bridge have been paved and beautiful walkways have been laid. The bridge, the gateway and the landmark of Kozhikode city, has been renovated as a historical monument. Muhammad Riyas said that new decorative lights will be prepared in the second phase with the aim of tourism development. A board describing the historical facts of the bridge will also be installed.

Management is important for the development of tourism. We have turned tourism into a celebration in a situation where the spread of the Corona virus is low. People have accepted the caravan policy implemented by the government based on safe travel, safe food, and safe accommodation and the caravan park at Vagamon. Time magazine has chosen Kerala as one of the major tourist destinations to visit in the world and it is a recognition for the tourism sector. The number of domestic tourists has increased.

Each individual should become a brand ambassador of tourism. As part of this, the Minister said that the work of the tourism club formed by the government, where the students and youth are mobilised, is appreciated. Also, the Public Works Department earned about four crores in a year through rest houses. Rest House online booking system has been used effectively by the people. More than half a lakh people have booked rooms online. The minister said that he has been able to provide good accommodation to the people at a low cost

The minister also mentioned that major roads in cities will be made pedestrian friendly as part of the design policy which is a crucial step in the future development of the state. The Design Policy is a first of its kind initiative in the country, implemented by the Department of Public Works and the Department of Tourism. Auto Rickshaw drivers in the state will be promoted as promoters of tourism. Modern toilets will be constructed under flyovers and in crowded public areas for long-distance commuters.

When people's ideas were sought through social media for the draft policy, there was a great response towards the new design policy. A design policy that radically changes the concepts of planning, design, and construction of buildings in the public works and tourism sectors will help make Kerala a global tourist destination. The minister also said that he made an official visit to all the assembly constituencies of the state in search of possibilities for implementation of design policy. The design policy is intended to frame the various activities planned and implemented by the Public Works Department and the Tourism Department emphasising the design perspective. For this, a comprehensive design of buildings, bridges, roads, signage, etc. in the state will be prepared in the workshop. Vacant underpasses of road overpasses can be effectively

utilised as part of the design policy. The minister said that the bridges of the rivers will be made attractive by electrification.

There is no abnormality in the vigilance inspection on the roads as most of the officials and contractors are doing their job well. The minister said that transparency should be ensured in all matters and corrective measures would be supported. A permanent system will be put in place to ensure the maintenance of the roads under the running contract scheme under the Public Works Department. A high-level team of officials is appointed for regular road maintenance inspections. Under the direction of the Minister of Public Works Department, a special team is currently conducting inspections in the districts under the leadership of the Department Secretary. The team will assess the report after the inspection and take further action. It is intended to establish a permanent system to find out the deficiencies and solve the deficiencies by the officials of the public works department on the roads under their responsibility. The Minister also informed that this system will enable the officers to go to the field and carry out inspections in a timely manner.

The inspection of the team formed on the instructions of the Public Works Department Minister was conducted in two teams in the Kannur, Kozhikode, Malappuram, and Thrissur districts. The team reviewed the current work done on the roads under running contracts in these districts. The team also assessed the existing condition of the roads. The inspections in Thiruvananthapuram, Idukki, and Ernakulum districts were completed on time. Inspections have also progressed in Kollam, Pathanamthitta, Alappuzha districts, and Kasaragod, Palakkad, Kottayam, and Wayanad districts have been inspected in recent days. The inspection team consisted of IAS officers in charge of the department's nodal officer, chief engineers, superintending engineers, and executive engineers, along with officials from the quality control wing. The team submitted a detailed report on the inspection to the Minister of Public Works.

KERALA'S TRANSPORT SYSTEM: **A CHANGING LANDSCAPE**

odern changes are taking place in the state's motor vehicle department. In the second year of the Pinarayi government, Transport Minister Antony Raju inaugurated a software system called Check Post Module at the state level, where the permit to cross the border without waiting at the check posts can now be obtained online. The border check posts used to experience a lot of congestion as taxi vehicles needed a special permit to enter and exit the state. But henceforth permits can be taken online. Permit fees and taxes can be paid online in advance from homes or e-Seva centres. The document

can be shown at the check posts and the journey can be continued. Earlier, various services of the Motor Vehicles Department were made online but one had to go directly to the check posts for the special travel permit. This method has been eliminated with the advent of online systems, and if any difference in fees or taxes is found, a temporary system will be introduced to settle the same.

Transport Minister Antony Raju had informed that KSRTC is ready to provide land, building and workshop for companies coming to Kerala to manufacture and assemble electric vehicles. Electric vehicle manufacturers do not have to struggle to find a place to start their business.

The Minister informed that the EVOLVE seminar organised by the Department o Motor Vehicles was a huge success and the event will be held in Kerala every year. Automobile researchers, battery manufacturers, start-ups and vehicle manufacturers shared ideas in the seminar, which was attended by foreign representatives in eight sessions.

People who are differently abled up to 45% will be allowed travel pass in buses. Till now the pass was for those with a 50 percent membership limit. Those booking a vehicle for recreational travel should inform the Motor Vehicle Department. The journey should be started only after the official checks and certificates are issued. Action will be taken against the owner along with the officer in charge if there is any violation of law in the vehicles. This is a state that has a system that notifies the vehicle owner of real-time speeding warnings. This contributed to the reduction in accidents in Kerala despite the heavy traffic.

Meanwhile, the KSRTC has been awarded the National Award. The City Circular Service in the capital and the Gram Vandi scheme in the state have received four approvals from the Ministry of Housing and Urban Affairs. The Corporation also received the award

for Best Public Participation in Gram Vandi, Award for Excellence in Urban Transport Conference, Best Planned Urban Public Transport and Special Award for Public Transport System. Transport Minister Antony Raju said that the sincere service of the employees is the sole reason behind the award.

The minister's response was in the context of frequent bus accidents. Six out of the 16 deaths in one-and-ahalf months were due to private bus racing. The minister responded that a committee will be formed at the state level and a study conducted to check the schedule of the bus and if the drivers do not have a licence, their fitness certificate and permit of the bus will be cancelled. Clusters of buses should be formed and revenues shared to end competition. The labour unions were tasked to take a decision about this. Road safety training will be given to bus drivers and conductors. Bus crews should undergo a comprehensive medical examination once in six months. The minister added that health cards will be issued for this purpose.

he civil supplies department, led by minister G. R. Anil has never failed in fulfilling its promise of ensuring food grains to all families in Kerala for the past two years of administration. Among the achievements of the department is the district inauguration of the Public Distribution Department's 'Oppam' scheme, which brings rations directly to the homes of the poor, needy and underprivileged in auto-rickshaws. It

was found that there are 6773 extremely poor families in the district. Out of this 451 people did not have ration cards. 375 people were given new cards. There is no family in the state without a card. Small grains grown in Kerala are being stocked and distributed through ration shops.

Ration shops will be modernised. The minister also said that the K-Store project will be implemented where all services will be available. In the first phase, 11 beneficiaries of the corporation will receive the benefit of the project. 251 deserving families belonging to the poorest category in the district will receive the ration directly to their homes through the scheme. In the second phase, 240 families will be part of the project.

This time too, it was possible to ensure that all ration card holders in the state received Onam kit and special arrangements were made to avoid congestion in ration shops. According to the estimate till 10 am, Onam kit has been distributed to 7 lakh card holders. Special days have been fixed for different categories of cardholders to purchase Onam kits to avoid rush. Those who could not buy on that day due to

inconvenience had the facility to do so on other days. In addition to free kits on Onam, all ration card holders were given rice and sugar at subsidised rates. A special system has been put in place to avoid the possibility of affecting the functioning of e-POS machines in ration shops if people arrive in large numbers. E-POS machines at ration shops have been switched to the latest range of Aadhar-based dispensing systems from April 1. Hyderabad NIC, which is preparing technical facilities, has been instructed in this regard.

Social intervention in the field of public distribution is a model for the country. The process of distribution of ration cards to all including non-state residents in the state is in the final stage. Supply Co deputation is being implemented in a phased manner. The government is trying to spread more awareness about people's rights in the food and public distribution system and address the shortcomings. It is important to be aware of consumer rights. Awareness program will be extended to all. There are 148 consumer clubs functioning in schools in the state. Work has begun to include consumer rights in the curriculum. The minister said that the government is considering a bill related to the implementation of a grading system to ensure the safety and cleanliness of hotel food.

Supply Co is on the path of modernization with changing times and technologies. Leveraging Supply Co's 48 years of experience and expertise, everything from the outlets to the head office will be modernised using modern technologies to ensure proper delivery and quality of products. The minister

also said that GPS tracking units will be installed in the vehicles used for distribution of food grains. In Kerala, the government intervenes to stop the soaring prices across the country and with effective market interventions inflation can be controlled.

Prices are also rising in food producing states. The measures to control the price of daily use items are to ensure minimum support price to the farmer. Kerala is the only state where prices of 13 food items have not increased since 2016. Supply Co and cooperative stores led by Consumer Fed play a major role in this. The LDF government has earmarked over ₹6,000 crore for food subsidy. About ₹1600 crore have been set aside annually for paddy storage. The rice produced from this is made available through ration shops free of cost. As part of controlling the price rise, the 'Arivandi' movement of the Civil Supplies Corporation has started. Each ration card holder can buy 10 kg of rice in four varieties at low cost. The rice van is running in 500 taluk/panchayat centres of the state where there are no Supply Co stores.

The minister said that the liver has not been affected by the huge price hike and only the prices of a few products have gone up. The minister added that it was the state government's intervention in the field of public distribution that stopped the price rise. About 500 wholesale trade centres in the state were inspected. There is no artificial inflation in the state. The price hike in Kerala is due to the crisis caused by climate change in the neighbouring states.



Working from home enables women to meet competing demands for their time while juggling a disproportionate share of housekeeping and childcare chores. However, social conventions are also at work. Women have little choice but to run these types of companies in communities where women are expected to stay at home or where traveling outside the home is risky.

ICTs are required to function in a world where digital is becoming the norm and a key component of corporate growth. Another impediment to ICT use among low-income women is technological illiteracy. Furthermore, public Internet access points supplied by business centers, libraries, and Internet cafés are not necessarily welcoming to women, with inconvenient operating hours or hazardous, socially unacceptable facilities.

Access to finance is frequently highlighted as a major impediment to the expansion of female-owned businesses. According to the Gallup World Poll, women and men-owned firms in developing nations have significantly different access to financial services. Women have limited access to

However, due to the small size and short term nature of micro-loans, women borrowers are unable to make long-term investments in their enterprises.

Legal and regulatory restrictions that are disproportionately high can also have a significant impact on women's capacity to manage stronger, more viable enterprises. Only 38 of the 141 economies surveyed by the Women, Business, and the Law database provide equal legal rights to men and women in critical areas such as establishing a bank account, working without permission from their husband, and owning and managing property.
